Entry classes: *(Self-assigned by each entrant – these are guidelines only)*

Apprentice: May be relatively inexperienced. May devote relatively little time and/or resources to photography. May be taking or have taken basic-level photography course work. May be re-exploring photography after a period of inactivity. Might not have been awarded ribbons in previous photographic competitions.

Intermediate: Those who consider themselves too experienced for the Apprentice class and not yet experienced enough for the Advanced class.

Advanced: May have won Best of Show in previous competitions. May compete at state, regional or higher levels. May earn all or part of living in photographically-related field.

Entry rules:

1. Competition is open to all RCC members in good standing.
2. Each entrant may submit up to a **total of four images**, in one or as many of the subject categories as desired.
3. Any image that has not won a ribbon in a previous RCC competition is eligible. There are no restrictions on when the image was originally created.
4. Images may be color or monochrome, created originally on film or by digital means, and may be digitally or otherwise enhanced or manipulated by the maker.
5. All entries must be the creative work of the entrant.
6. Entrant's name should not appear within the image.
7. Images are to be entered on our website at www.redlandscameraclub.com using the online entry form. The entry form will be available for two weeks prior to each competition.
8. **Each image file must be in the .JPG file format with a file size of less than 3,500KB (3.5MB)**
 - a. Resolution should be **no less than 72 ppi**. Size to 1280 pixels on the long side.
 - b. A color space of **sRGB**
9. Name each file as follows: Name the file the same as the title of your image. If the title of your image is stormy weather, then your file name would be stormyweather.jpg. **Please don't put any punctuation, capitol letters or spaces in the file name.**
